Annual Objectives for Safety Improvement

1. Identify and remediate slip, trip and fall hazards in headquarters building.
2. Develop procedures to identify chain of command and improve communications during emergency and power restoration events.
3. Enhance safety of line personnel working with OCR controls

Develop Procedures to identify chain of command and improve communications during emergency and power restoration events, including: • Designation of Lineman-in-Charge in the field during each event with responsibility to communicate with dispatcher and ensuring compliance with all safety requirements • Identification and communication to dispatcher all persons involved in working the event	Operations Manager and Operations Supervisor	Complete by August 1, 2023

D. Design new OCR Pole configuration to support clearance order procedures requiring confirmation of visual open, and develop plan for field implementation of new design	Chief Operating Officer and Operations Manager	Complete design and plan by July 1, 2023; Implementation over next five years
